Installation Instructions

- 1. Download ipa file from the TripIt website
- 2. Import ipa file into iTunes
- 3. Connect device to iTunes and install application by clicking install and sync

Usage notes:

1. When a keyboard is up (not the search keyboards), tap anywhere on the screen to dismiss it, or hit return

Wizard of Oz:

We have a few different pieces of our application that are hard coded.

- 1. The contacts list is hard coded, and doesn't come from the users contacts/Facebook like we would have in the real app
- 2. The inspirational destinations section only has two hard coded locations. Ideally this section would contain locations that are trending, or have cheap flights, etc.
- 3. When voting on locations, we have a preset list that you can vote on, and the locations you can add is also a preset list.
- 4. The flights section always has Cabo as the winning location, but in reality this would be the location that actually won the vote amongst your friends.
- 5. The last part where it says you should receive a notification once everyone confirms is left unimplemented and just sends you back to the menu screen.

Known Bugs:

- 1. If you are adding the trip name and go to the next screen while the keyboard is still up, and then go back, the keyboard is covering the text box. You can tap anywhere to dismiss it
- 2. iOS seems to use different tables/cells when searching vs. the regular table. Because of this, if you invite someone while searching, it won't persist when you go back to the whole contacts view. Similarly, if you add a location by searching and then clicking on it, it adds the wrong location.
- 3. If you click on the flights tab before the dates tab, it crashes because the dates are not initialized.

Note about the bugs:

These are all things we could fix with some more time and effort, but seeing as how the class was about the UI and user experience, we felt our time was best allocated elsewhere, but we wanted to let and readers know that we are aware of the existence of these bugs.
