TripIt Medium-Fi Prototype

General Notes:

- Clicking on the screen will highlight the boxes which are clickable
 - This lets you to see which buttons are clickable and which aren't
- There is a back button at the top of most screens, this will let you navigate to the previous screen
- In general the button at the bottom with the arrow lets you move on to the next screen
- It is a very linear flow going through the creation, voting, and booking process.
- Once the notification comes saying your friends have joined, the creator has no authoritative powers
 - Because of this, the rest of the application is from the POV of anyone on the trip, not necessarily the creator
 - Everyone gets to vote, pick dates, etc. in an equal manner

Notes:

- All of the location/date information is hard coded into our prototype, but in the actual application you would be able to input all of this dynamically.
- The search functionality, e.g. friends and locations, will also be dynamic, but for now it is auto-filled for the prototype.
- The prototype forces you to vote for specific locations and select certain friends, but again this will be general and dynamic when the app is complete.
