About CS194H

CS194H is a project-based capstone course in Computer Science (CS) for Stanford students interested in Human-Computer-Interaction (HCI) and Design. The majority of students take the class to fulfill a senior capstone requirement that all CS majors have to fulfill. The course focuses on user experience design through a quarter-long project that continues an existing prototype started in our introductory HCI course (CS147: Introduction to Human-Computer-Interaction). This quarter the focus is on building mobile products. The 5 student team projects cover topics from education to collaborative music-sharing.

Each of this quarter's five teams is comprised of an interdisciplinary group of upperclassmen with strengths in design and development. The teams tackle deliverables throughout the quarter towards a finished, polished product culminating in a real world ready launch. 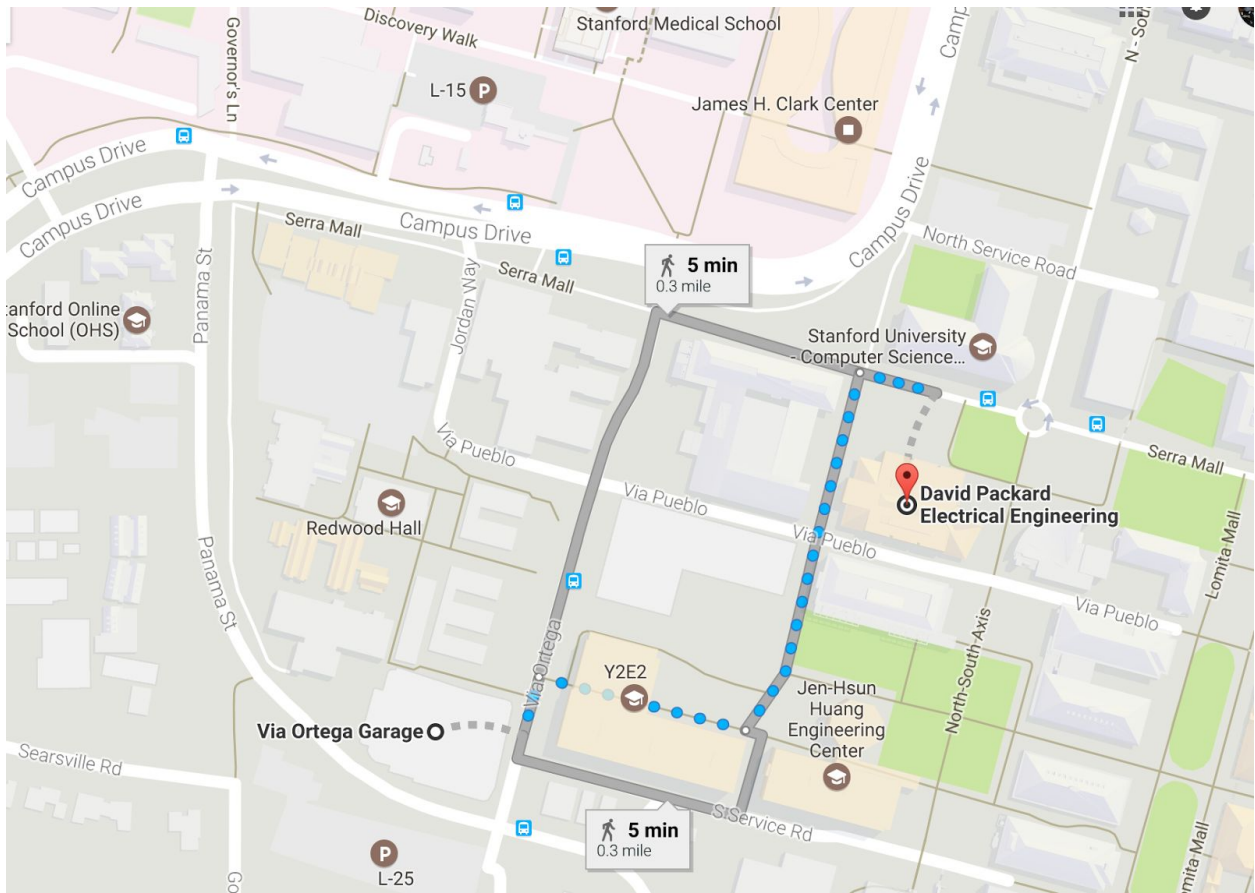
