


ButterflyNet Basics

Notebook view



Timeline view

Shows # of notebook pages started on that day (click to go to first page from that day)

Notebook view

Left-click and drag in a page to make a selection and copy it to clipboard

Page timestamp

Tells you when page was written (first and last edits)

Photo context pane

Shows imported pictures taken on same day as page

Import photos

Import (copy) images into ButterflyNet system

User/notebook selection (not currently used)

Refresh button

Use after synchronizing pen to show new notebook data

Back one screen (notebook/calendar)

Current page (notebook view only)

Click to enter a page number in text field to view in notebook

Forward one screen (notebook/calendar)

Zoom slider

Controls view of notebook
- 1 page (leftmost)
- 2 pages across
- 4 pages across
- Calendar (rightmost)

Keyboard shortcuts:

L, R arrows	Back/forward one page
U, D arrows	Back/forward one page
PageUp	Back one screen
PageDown	Forward one screen
Home	First written page
End	Last written page

Pie menu (open with right click on page):

Zoom out	(doesn't work yet)
Previous	Back one screen
Next	Forward one screen
Copy	Copy whole page to clipboard
