Talking points will help users schedule productive meetings with clear purpose.



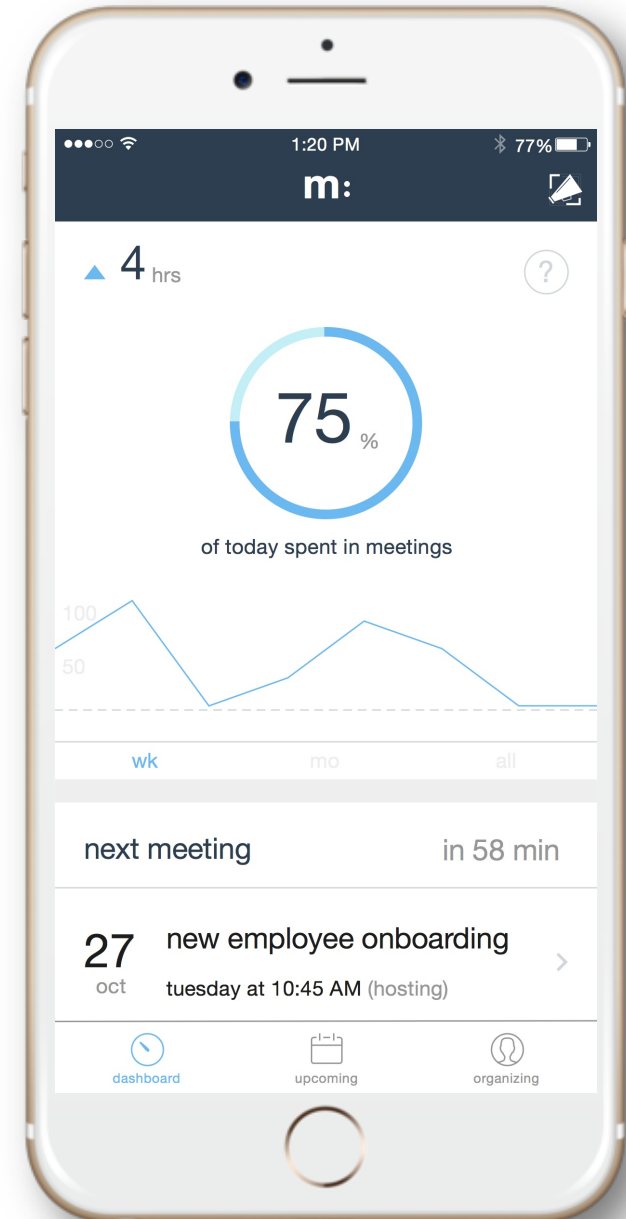
upcoming

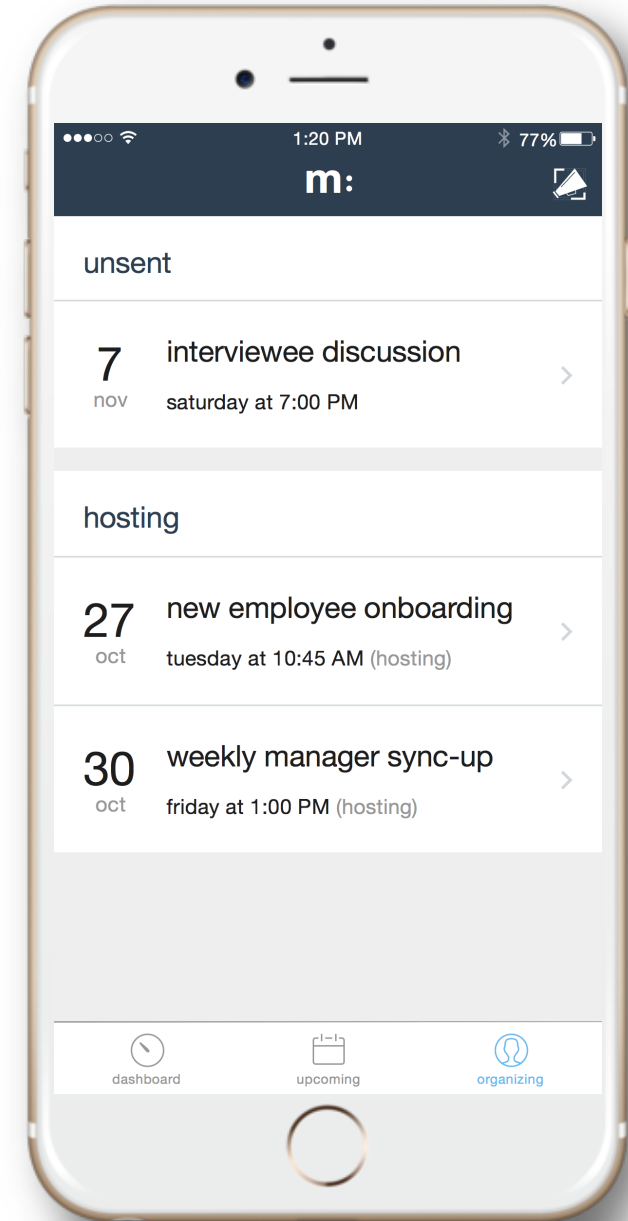

[H2-9: User Control and Freedom] [Severity 4]

- No option for creating another meeting without sending or canceling the current meeting.
- If the user wanted to make multiple meetings before sending them to attendees, they would not be able to.
- **Implement a save function for meetings.**

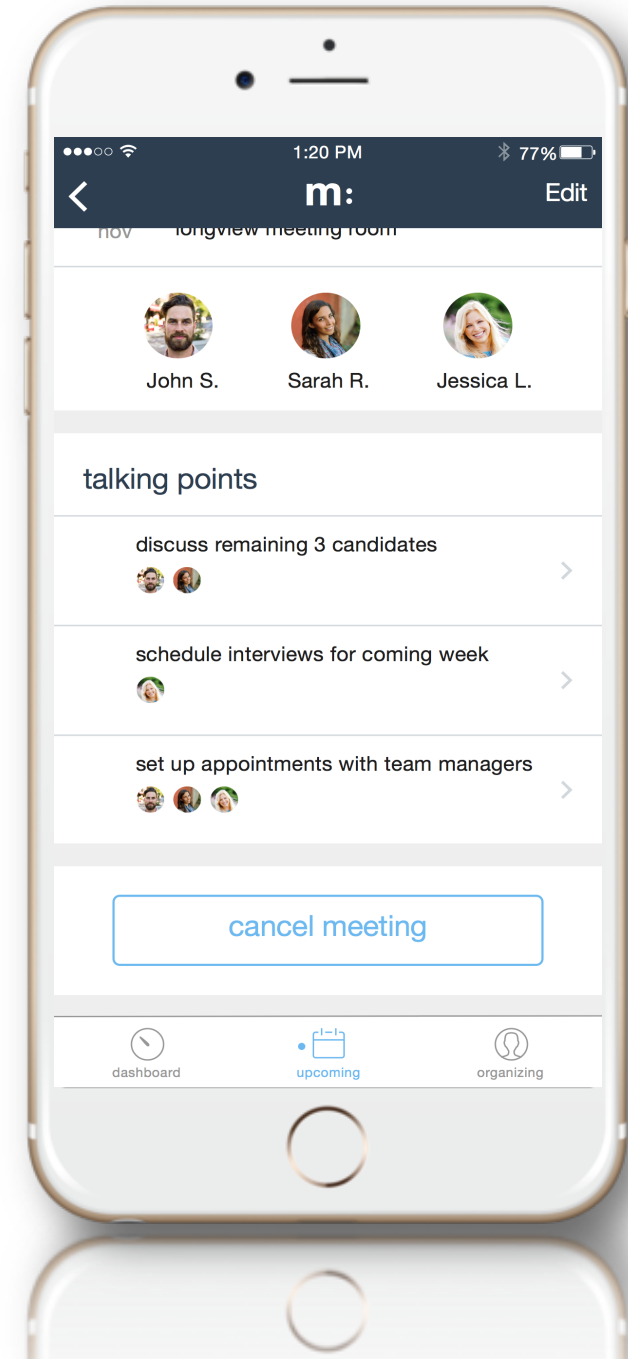
Our Solution: Added additional screen to access unfinished meeting invites and start new meetings



[H2-9: User Control and Freedom] [Severity 4]

- No way to edit/delete a meeting
- Add an edit/delete button of the Meetings screen.

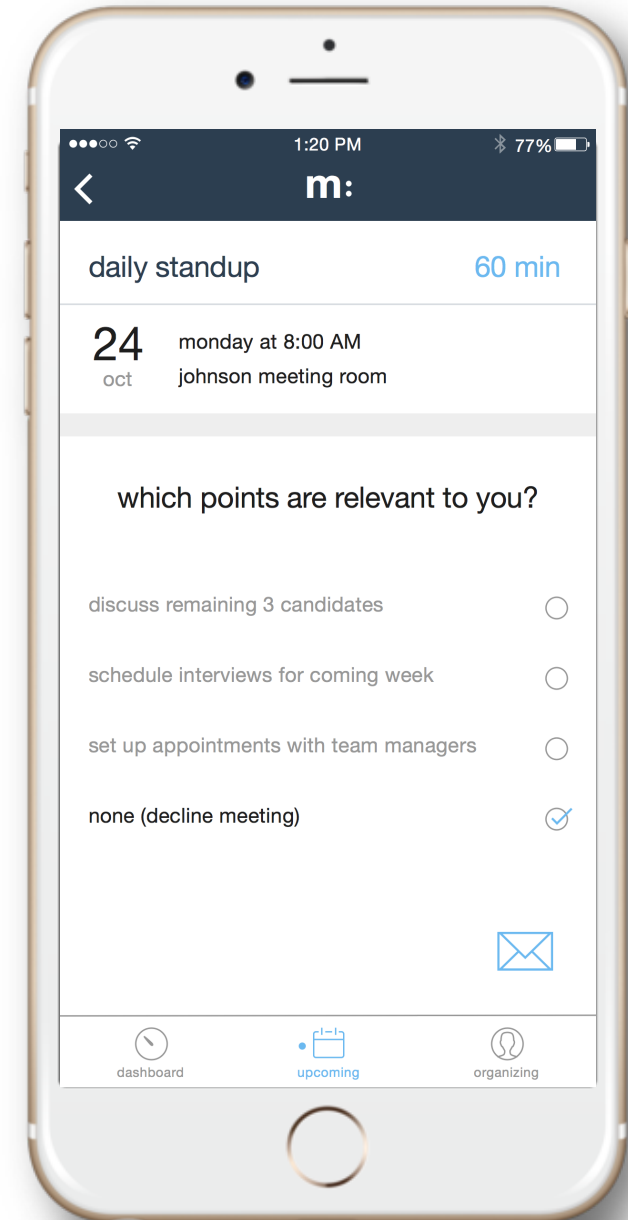
Our Solution: Added functionality to edit and delete meeting upon clicking of existing meeting that you are organizing.



[H2-9: User Control and Freedom] [Severity 4]

- No way for user to easily decline an invite
- Highly necessary given purpose of application
- Add a 'decline invitation' button.

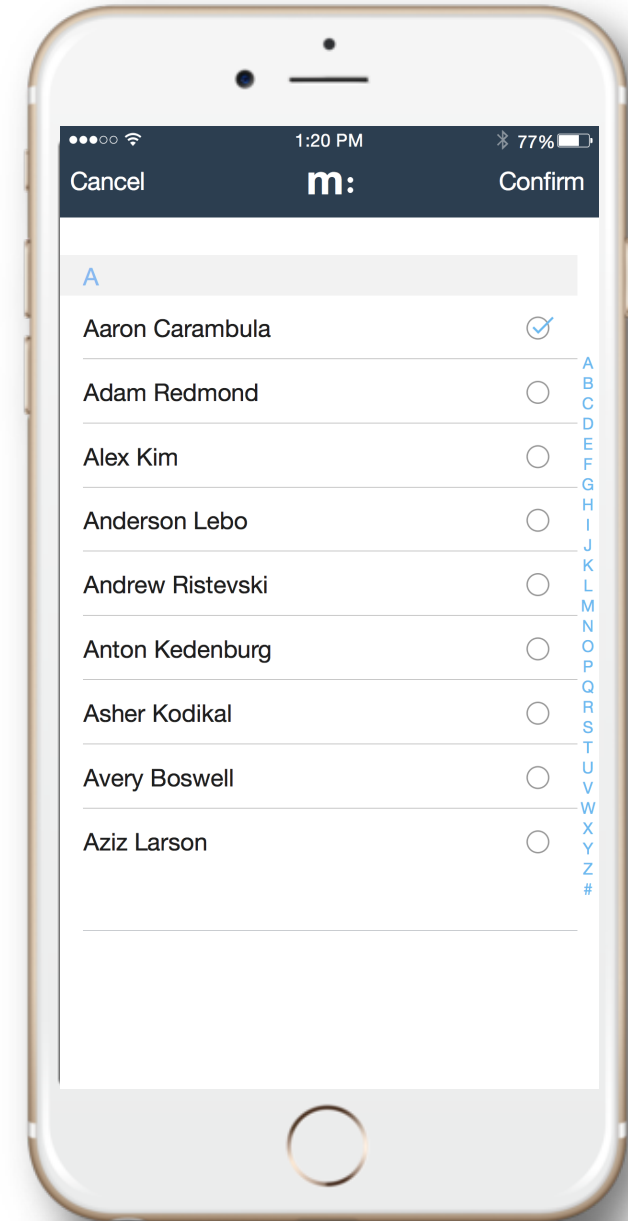
Our Solution: Declining option was to say 'none' on talking points. Updated copy of this option to make it clearer.



[H2-7: Flexibility and Efficiency of Use] [Severity 4]

- No option for selecting multiple people, all people, or groups of people on contact screen
- Organizer may want to skip selecting specific people and just select a group and have the members decide if they should be there or not
- Add a select all or allow for creating contact groups (recent, frequent, mobile team).

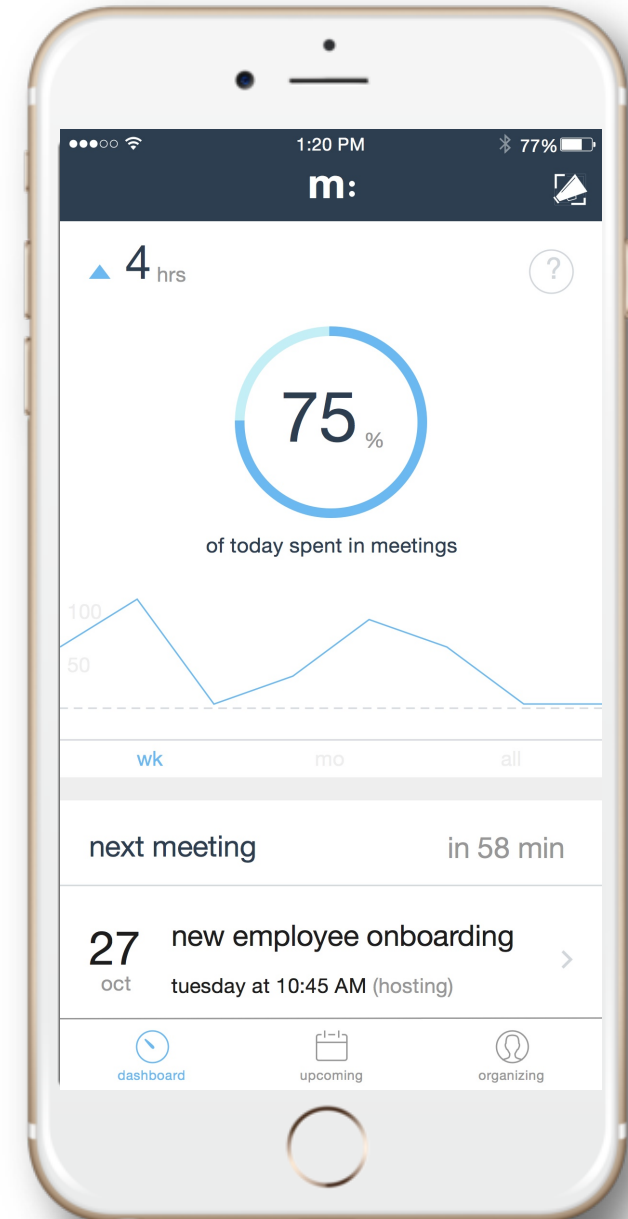
Our Solution: Added option to select multiple contacts on single click.



[H2-1: Visibility of System Status] [Severity 4]

- Home screen does not make sense
- Users will be interested in in checking an upcoming meeting first.
- First screen should be a list of upcoming meetings.

Our Solution: Changed landing screen to show upcoming messages.



[H2-6: Recognition Rather than Recall] [Severity 4]

- Add meeting time to all meeting related screens
- Change titles of stats to make them more understandable

[H2-3: User Control and Freedom] [Severity 4]

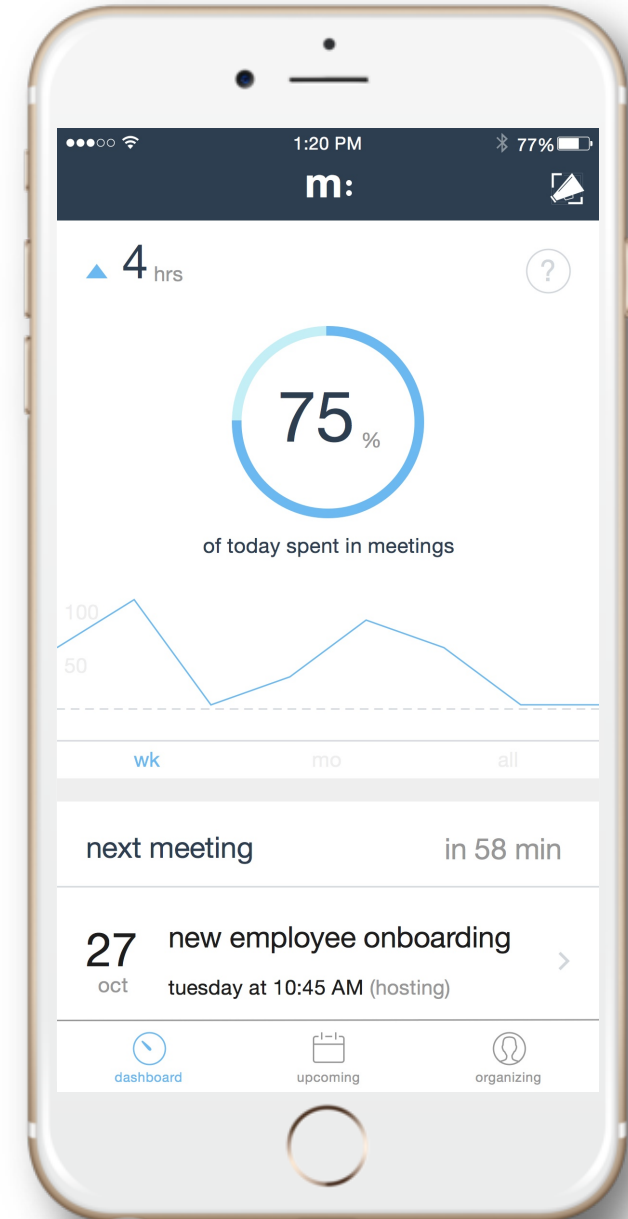
- Cancel out of create new meeting screen

[H2-9: Help Users with Errors] [Severity 4]

- Implement error messages in Hi-Fi prototype

[H2-10: Help and Documentation] [Severity 5]

- Add tutorials when user on boards
- Provide other help and documentation
