




Low-fi Prototype > Simple Task

Consumers find nearby restaurants offering flash promotions




Low-fi Prototype > Medium Task

 Consumers track their eating and spending habits over time





Low-fi Prototype > Complex Task

- Compensation



- He pinched when he was trying to zoom





2	Attempted to pinch instead of click to enlarge graph	3	Change how the graph is displayed to make it more obvious that the user should tap.


