

## Chill Zone Medium-Fi Prototype README

What we used:

The medium-fi prototype was rendered in Sketch and is implemented onto our website via Marvel (marvelapp.com). Marvel is a web-based interactive prototype presentation tool that allows a user to easily navigate between screens of an app prototype.

Operating Instructions:

To use the medium-fi prototype, click through the screens to navigate the different screen flows of our app. To see what buttons are clickable, click anywhere on the screen and the clickable buttons will flash blue. Feel free to click as many buttons as you would like in order to familiarize yourself with the app. If at anytime you need to go back to the previous screen, just click the back button in the top left.

Limitations:

There were some limitations that arose with the medium-fi prototype. Marvel app does not support live videos and therefore our prototype does not contain any live videos, which are an essential part of our app because they provide the tutorials of the exercises. Another limitation is the lack of randomization of the exercises and videos that come up. We would have liked a different 5 minute exercise to come up each time one was requested, but we could not implement this functionality through the Marvel app.

The prototype also does not provide the interactivity/functionality for adding videos to favorites, which we would like to support, so that the users can personalize their experience and find their favorite exercises.

The prototype also does not support the interactive tracking of progress and graphing functionality nor does it support social media sharing functionality.

Each of these feature limitations are essential and will be implemented for the high-fi prototype.
