THERE ARE THREE TYPES OF RESOURCES:

- MANDATORY REPORTER**
CAMPUS MANDATORY REPORTERS ARE OBLIGATED TO REPORT THE INCIDENTS TO THE TITLE IX OFFICE, WHO WILL NOT NOTIFY THE PERPETRATOR UNLESS THE VICTIM SAYS SO. THE TITLE IX OFFICE WILL NOT SHARE WITH ANY INVESTIGATION UNLESS YOU WANT THEM TO (SUPPORTS INCLUDE MULTIPLE ACCUSATIONS AGAINST THE SAME PERSON, A VERY SERIOUS INCIDENT, AND MULTIPLE INCIDENTS IN THE SAME PLACE) BUT WILL CREATE A FILE OF THE INCIDENT
- CONFIDENTIAL**
TYPICALLY PROTECTED BY LICENSES THAT EXEMPT THEM FROM REPORTING OBLIGATIONS. INCLUDE SOCIAL WORKERS, CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGISTS, AND RELIGIOUS LEADERS.
- ANONYMOUS**
OBLIGATED TO REPORT SEXUAL ASSAULT AND/OR VIOLENCE ONLY IF THEY HAVE IDENTIFYING INFORMATION, WHICH THEY WILL NOT ASK FOR.

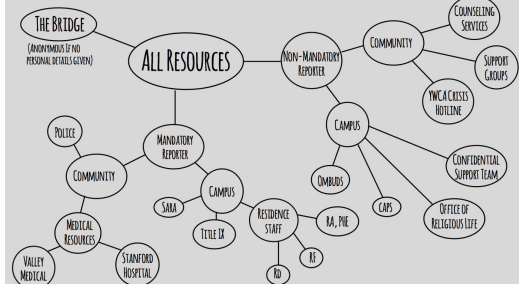

YOU TELL A MANDATORY REPORTER

YOU CAN DEVELOP INFORMAL RESOLUTIONS TO FEEL SAFER ON CAMPUS, FROM POLICE ESCORTS TO HOUSING MOVES, TO CLASS SCHEDULE CHANGES TO BANNING THE RESPONDING FROM CERTAIN AREAS OF CAMPUS. THE TITLE IX OFFICER CAN ALSO PROCEED WITH THE ARP INVESTIGATION PROCESS IF YOU CHOOSE FOR THEM TO DO SO.

TITLE IX REACHES OUT TO YOU. IF YOU DON'T WANT THEM TO OPEN AN INVESTIGATION, THEY ALMOST NEVER WILL (UNLESS THE PERSON HAS BEEN NAMED BY SEVERAL SURVIVORS). A REPRESENTATIVE WILL TYPICALLY SEND 1-2 EMAILS CHECKING IN.

THE TITLE IX INVESTIGATOR INTERVIEWS THE IMPACTED PARTY AND THEN SENDS A TYPED-UP TRANSCRIPT TO THE IMPACTED PARTY FOR VERIFICATION. THE INVESTIGATOR THEN DOES THE SAME WITH THE RESPONDING PARTY AND WITNESSES.

Prototyping Tools

❑ Sketch

- ❑ Pros: Gives functionality to create computer images
- ❑ Cons: Lines, Layering, and Font Defaults were difficult to deal with

❑ Invision

- ❑ Pros: Assisted in creating a quick prototype for users to get the real experience of clicking through the application
- ❑ Cons: Some functionality was complex and difficult to understand. There isn't a way to apply a "hot spot" click to multiple locations

Features Left Out/Limitations

- ❑ The survey aspect isn't functional at this time - always sends the user's to CAPS
- ❑ The Support chat feature isn't working at this point
- ❑ Due to issues with Invision, our screen was slightly larger than the window in our prototype
- ❑ No Schedule an appointment / pictures

THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR STANFORD STUDENTS."

- EXEMPT FROM REPORTING OBLIGATIONS BECAUSE THE CST IS COMPOSED OF SOCIAL WORKERS AND CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGISTS
- THE CST WAS CREATED SPECIFICALLY TO HELP WITH CAMPUS SEXUAL ASSAULT
- CAN HELP CONNECT SURVIVORS TO OTHER ON-CAMPUS AND OFF-CAMPUS RESOURCES

VALLEY MEDICAL SEXUAL ASSAULT RESPONSE TEAM

IN SAN JOSE, GIVE IMMEDIATE HELP, MANDATORY REPORTERS
PURPOSE: "THE SEXUAL ASSAULT RESPONSE TEAM (SART) PROVIDES MEDICAL AND FORENSIC RESPONSE TO VICTIMS OF SEXUAL ASSAULT, 12 YEARS AND OLDER, WHO COME INTO OUR EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT, 24 HOURS A DAY. THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY 20 SPECIALLY TRAINED REGISTERED NURSES WHO SERVE AS SART NURSE EXAMINERS. THE SART NURSE EXAMINERS RESPOND TO PATIENTS WHO COME TO THE SCVMC EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT. THE SART NURSE EXAMINER PROVIDES MEDICAL EVALUATION AND TREATMENT, COLLECTS EVIDENCE FOR FORENSIC PURPOSES, AND WILL TESTIFY IN COURT AS NECESSARY. DR. JAMES B. LANE IS THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR OF THE SART PROGRAM."

- ONLY NEARBY PLACE THAT CAN COLLECT PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OF A SEXUAL ASSAULT
- REQUIRED TO CALL THE POLICE WHEN THEY BELIEVE A SEXUAL ASSAULT HAS OCCURRED
- ALSO CALL A TRAINED VICTIM'S RIGHTS ADVOCATE WHO STAYS WITH THE VICTIM THROUGHOUT QUESTIONING AND GETS GUIDANCE ON THE LEGAL REPORTING PROCESS.

STANFORD UNIVERSITY IS COMMITTED TO PROVIDING AN ENVIRONMENT FREE OF DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF SEX (GENDER), INCLUDING SEXUAL HARASSMENT, SEXUAL MISCONDUCT, SEXUAL ASSAULT, RELATIONSHIP (DATING AND DOMESTIC) VIOLENCE, AND STALKING. - THIS TYPICALLY HAPPENS WHEN THERE ARE MULTIPLE ACCUSATIONS OF THE SAME PERSON, MULTIPLE ACCUSATIONS IN THE SAME PLACE, OR A REALLY VIOLENT INCIDENT
- THEY CAN ALSO TAKE OTHER MEASURES BEFORE OR INSTEAD OF A FULL INVESTIGATION, LIKE STAY-AWAY ORDERS OR MOVING MOVIES
- HEART UNLIKELY TO MOVE FORWARD WITHOUT YOU WANTING THEM TO.

PURPOSE: "RESIDENT FELLOWS, OR RFS, ARE STANFORD FACULTY AND, OCCASIONALLY, SENIOR ADMINS/TRAINEE STAFF WHO LIVE APARTMENTS OR COTTAGES IN OR ADJACENT TO STUDENT RESIDENCES AND ACT AS LEADERS FOR THEIR COMMUNITIES. THEY WORK WITH THE LOCAL STAFF TO BUILD AN ENVIRONMENT THAT SYNTHESIZES AND CONTEXTUALIZES STUDENTS' EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE AND SUPPORTS STUDENTS' PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT."

RESIDENT ASSISTANTS/PEER HEALTH EDUCATORS

ON CAMPUS, TYPICALLY AVAILABLE TO TEXT/CALL IN ANY EMERGENCY, MANDATORY REPORTER

PURPOSE: RAs AND PHES ARE STUDENT STAFF MEMBERS IN ALL UNDERGRADUATE UNIVERSITY RESIDENCES. THEY HELP FOSTER COMMUNITY IN DOOMS AND OFTEN HAVE A CLOSE RELATIONSHIP WITH THE STUDENTS IN THEIR HOUSE/ROOM

- RAs AND PHES ARE TRAINED TO HELP STUDENTS IN CRISIS
- A SURVIVOR CAN TALK TO THEM ON INFORMALS ABOUT ANYTHING, BUT THEY DO HAVE TO REPORT IF THEY HAVE REASON TO BELIEVE A CRIME TOOK PLACE

DEPENDS ON CAMPUS RESIDENCE AND YEAR. YOU SHOULD BE ABLE TO FIND THEM IN YOUR HALL.

RESIDENCE DEANS

ON CAMPUS, MANDATORY REPORTER

PURPOSE: "RESIDENCE DEANS, OR RDs AS THEY ARE OFTEN CALLED, ARE RESED PROFESSIONAL STAFF THAT ARE HERE TO HELP STUDENTS NAVIGATE THEIR UNDERGRADUATE EXPERIENCE AT STANFORD. AN RD'S MAIN PURPOSE IS TO ASSIST AND SUPPORT STUDENTS THROUGH DIFFICULT AND/OR CHALLENGING TIMES. RDs KNOW THE OPTIONS AND RESOURCES AVAILABLE ACROSS CAMPUS TO ADDRESS WHATEVER ISSUE IS INTERFERING WITH YOUR SUCCESS AT STANFORD."

- TALKED WITH HELPING SURVIVORS NAVIGATE THE PROCESS
- WILL BE A POINT OF CONTACT FOR ALL OTHER RESIDENCE STAFF MEMBERS (STUDENT STAFF AND RESIDENT FELLOWS)
