



Problem


- Students are embarrassed to ask questions in front of their classmates.

- Teachers can't effectively target their struggling students.




Solution



Students ask private questions




Teachers review questions in real-time

Design Process



Low-Fi Prototype

User Test Findings:

- Binary data wasn't helpful for teachers
- In-class polling was too time consuming

Solutions:

 Teachers add predefined topics for students to select



Medium-Fi Prototype

Heuristic Evaluation:

- Inputting topics adds work for teachers
- "Threshold exceeded" alert is disruptive

Solutions:

• Students submit questions privately to teacher's dashboard
