

## README: Medium-Fi Prototype Instructions and Usage

Team: Dazzle

1. First, navigate to the medium-fi prototype by going to this url:  
<http://web.stanford.edu/class/cs147/projects/learning/DASL/>
2. Once you're on this website, you will want to scroll down to the "Design Process" section and under the "Medium-Fi Prototype" header, you will want to click that link.
3. Now that you are on the invasion prototype, to use the prototype is quite simple. First you start off at the sign-in/registration page. Click on the various buttons will move you throughout this menu.
4. Once you successfully sign in or sign up, you will be redirected to the homepage where there is a list of activities among "Speak", "Draw", "Group", and "Draw."
5. Selecting each one of the activities brings you to a new UI screen specific to that screen, where "Speak" allows you to record your speech and each input you give, and similarly for typing in "Type" for input, or drawing for "Draw."
6. The group activity in a round-robin where each group member takes turns to give answers to the question at hand.
7. The prototype also allows for access to the user's profile or settings page, and of course, the adding of a new question to the list of activities.

\*Limitations to the current prototype include that all of the data is hardcoded. None of the UI is actually operational but rather just shows the screens for each feature. We are still in the process of designing the interface and will most likely iterate on various designs. We are thinking of changing the style of the "add question" button.
