The Solution: Ajar gives parents a low-pressure platform through which to share honestly about their experiences and encourage one another along the journey.



Major Design Change #1: Home Screen (Before)

Wed, Oct 2/s1



Description

- Two jars take up equal space on screen
- No directions or obvious buttons

Feedback

- Users: Didn't know to tap on jars to open, didn't t understand random friend feature
- Studio: Daily question jar only on home screen

Major Design Change #1: Home Screen (After)

The Fix

- Daily question jar central on home screen
- Instructive "Tap to view" bubble
- "View friends" button initially hides complexity of task #3

Description

- Random friend jar on home screen
- No functionality for viewing other friends

Feedback


- Users: confused by lack of friend searching functionality
- Studio/CA: Newsstand-type shelf of friend jars

Major Design Change #2: View Friends (After)


The Fix

- Grid/shelf of labeled friend jars
- Tap friend jars to view basic info about most recent posts



- Like or comment


Feedback

 Users: Missed the "more" button, ignored interaction functionality


Major Design Change #3: Interactions (After)

The Fix


- Display notes in entirety with scrolling

- Send advice and encouragement directly









Prototyping Tools

- Sketch design, layout
- Marvel interactions (clicks, swipes, switching screens)

- What helped: Copy and paste in Sketch allowed for consistent alignment and similar pages
- What didn't: Swipe interactions difficult in Marvel

Limitations

- No real user input
- Limited content
- Only Grace and Mary's jars clickable on friend page
- Scrolling bar on left of Daily Question jar doesn't scroll
- Can only view today and yesterday's questions
