Heuristic Evaluation Results

Level 3-4

H2-1: Difficult to track of where you are in app

H2-1: “Encourage a friend” title isn’t elaborative

H2-4: White text on background difficult to read

H2-4: Purpose of date label inside arrow

H2-4: Redirection after composing note

H2-6: “Tap jar to view” only on first jar

H2-7: No way to answer question on landing page

H2-10: Privacy of “Leave a note” unclear

Navigation Control

Revised Design Focus I

Menu Navigation

Question, Friends, Profile

Three consistent buttons along
bottom of every screen

Better-connected “< Back” buttons

→ Decreases user confusion

→ Allows for larger number of
screen switches per unit time

Text Readability

Revised Design Focus II

Select backgrounds based on

- Relevancy
- Brightness-Contrast

→ Textual readability is priority

→ Want to maintain aesthetic feel of prototype



Community Interactions

Revised Design Focus III

Public comments

No private messaging

→ Facilitates community-building

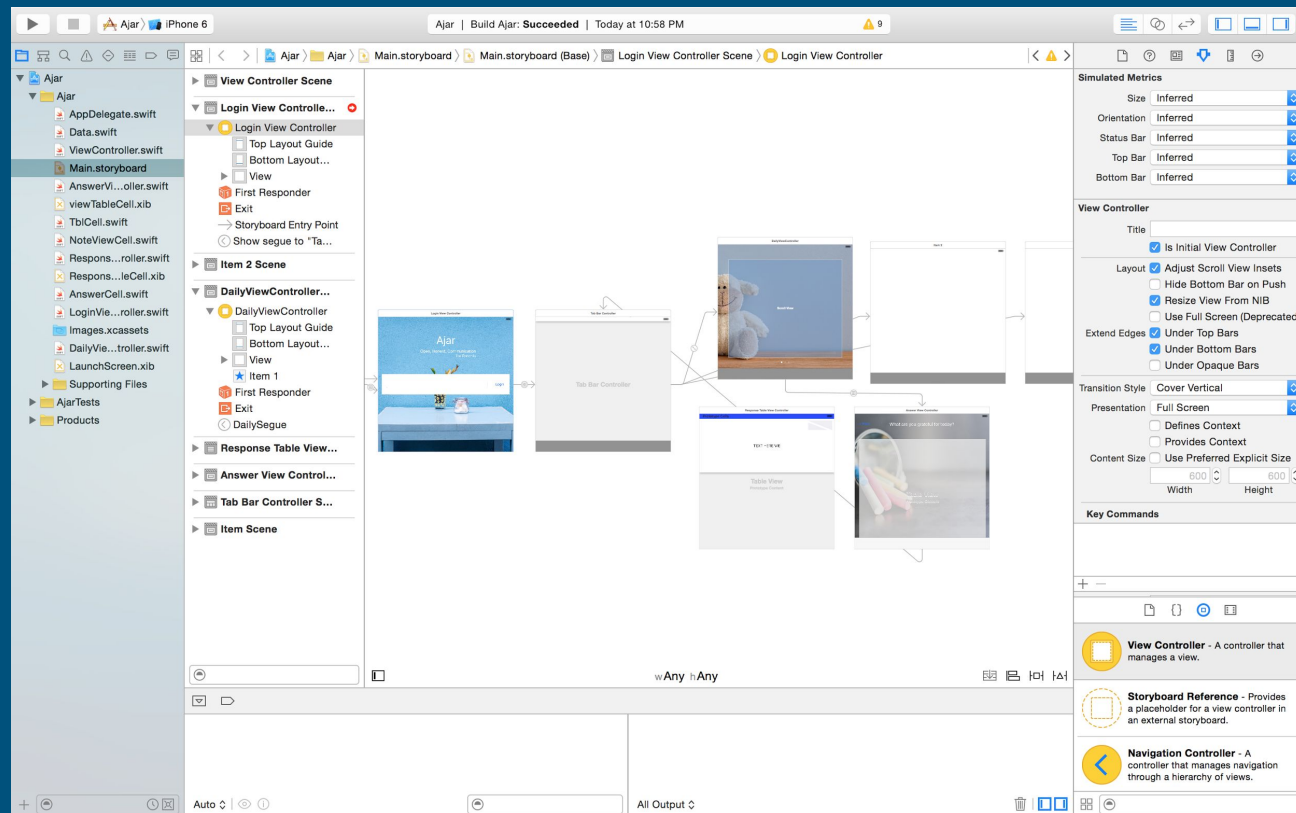
→ Doesn't compete with other private messaging app
