

Installation requirements:

This app works best on an iPhone 6 mobile device (**Important Note:** If you use an iPhone that is version 5s or earlier, some of the functionality will not be viewable). In order to execute the app, simply download the application and open it in iTunes. From there, you can sync this to your mobile device.

Using The App:

These are the main tasks that users can view in this application:

1. Users can login into the application and be taken to a daily question page. Here, users can scroll through different jars containing questions from different days and tap one to view the responses contained in the jar.
2. Once inside a jar, users have the option of adding their own responses to the question or adding their own comments. They can add their own responses by first tapping the 'add' button at the bottom of the screen. By doing so, users will be taken to a page that allows them to type in their own response. By tapping the 'post' button on that page, the user's response will be added. They can also add comments by tapping the '-comments-' button on each individual response. From there, they will be taken to a page that allows them to view other comments and add their own.
3. Users can also view their friends and add new friends. To do this, they simply have to tap the second tab in the bottom navigation bar, and then press the add button at the bottom. Here, they can see a list of friends that they can add.
4. Users also have the option of editing their profile page. They can do so by tapping the third tab in the bottom navigation bar and tapping the arrow next to 'Select Location' or 'Select # of Children.' By doing so, they will be taken to a page where they can scroll through a list of options and select them.

Limitations:

Here are the things in our app that are hard-coded:

1. The user's name, friends, and list of potential friends.
2. Each of their friend's responses
3. The question for 'Today' and the question for 'Yesterday'
4. The user's name is always 'Amy'.

The app is also only constrained to work as intended on an iPhone 6.
