





We present challenges in a fun social setting to help musicians break out of their comfort zone



Looked mainly for confusion


Results/Discussion/Changes

Confused by wording in the challenge description

Concerned about the difficulty of actually doing a challenge

Wanted a way to ignore challenge requests



Discussion/Changes

- Redrew the onboarding images
- Added explanations to empty pages
- Changed wording on several buttons
- Added the ability to ignore challenges


Participant #3
