

# Vesta Medium-Fi Prototype README

## General Notes

- The Vesta Medium-Fi prototype was created on and runs via the Marvel Prototyping site, found at the following URL: <https://www.marvelapp.com/> .
- The application has a home screen that it will always return to after a particular task is done or something is dismissed. Tap on the large Vesta logo in the center to begin or tap on the question mark in the top right corner to get reminders on what Vesta can do.
- To navigate, tap on the relevant button.
- On all of the pages, the question mark button will be present as a simple reminder of what Vesta can do. There are also back buttons on every screen that will take the user to the previous page.
- If confused on which buttons have been implemented, simply tap on an empty part of the screen and all possible tap locations will be highlighted in blue. If lost, the user can return to the home screen by simply tapping the back button until they get there.

## Limitations

We were unable to bundle in voice or sound into the medium-fi prototype due to Marvel's interface. Similarly, we have not implemented any scrolling functionality due to the limitations of Marvel. We have also hardcoded the links necessary to show each task flow, while leaving some extraneous buttons unlinked. As such, the prototype offers predefined suggestions; the real application would offer music suggestions tailored to the user. Finally, the user cannot input any data into the alarm screen's 'Event' and 'Mood' fields (in the actual app, this would mainly be controlled through vocal input, which is unavailable in Marvel).
