## Annote: A collaborative annotation tool README

### Tools:

- The Annote prototype runs on Invision ([invisionapp.com](http://invisionapp.com))
- The design of the screens was made using Sketch ([sketchapp.com](http://sketchapp.com))

### Operating Instructions:

- Tapping on 'log in' will take users to their groups
- On the groups screen, tapping on a group name will take users to their readings within that group
  - On the groups screen, tapping the plus button will bring users to the 'add a group' screen
- On the readings screen, (if an admin) tapping the plus will allow users to add a new reading
  - On the readings screen, (if an admin) tapping the 'group info' button will allow users to see administrative tools and stats on the readings in that group
- On the readings screen, tapping a reading will bring users to that reading
  - When viewing a reading, tapping on top or bottom white space will overlay a navbar and pagetracker at the top and bottom of the screen, respectively
- When viewing a reading, tapping on the rightmost whitespace will overlay annotation indicator(s), showing how many interactions have been made with each line
- While an annotation indicator overlay is visible, tapping an annotation indicator will overlay an annotation feed
- Tapping 'reply' on the first comment will allow users to reply to the comment
- When viewing a reading, tapping on a line, specifically "They'll see how beautiful I am", will allow users to add specific annotations to that line

### Limitations:

- There is not an annotation flow for every line of the reading. Invision would require far too many hotspots for what could be accomplished with one line.
- There is only one group and reading that are functioning for the purpose of brevity. Going through the tasks with one group and one reading demonstrate all of the features of the task flow.
- Navigation bar is still being fleshed out and so is currently left out of this prototype.
- This prototype does not have onboarding because we anticipate each user will only use the once, and we wanted to mimic the everyday experience.
  - There will ideally be a one-time onboarding the very first time you use Annote
  - There will also be a help button in the navigation bar that will explain any functionality covered in onboarding for later use.
