## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:**

This medium-fi mobile prototype was built using Marvel. It emulates an iPhone X. Clickable regions are highlighted, signalling to users where they can click to perform an action.

## **WIZARD-OF-OZ + HARD-CODED FEATURES:**

- Text on the login page
- Text on the page to capture elements
- Text on the project summary pages
- The AI-generated list of people to talk to
- The AI-generated prefilling of the newsroom summary
- Selecting elements to send to the newsroom
- Previously-inputted elements, projects, profile information, and organization information

## **LIMITATIONS:**

We couldn't use Marvel to allow users to enter whatever they wanted. Instead, they clicked the regions that they'd touch if they were using the app as a journalist. Since a core element of this application is an Al-driven backend that learns from the user, these features couldn't realistically be built into this medium-fi prototype.

To focus specifically on our three tasks, we simplified taskflows and left out a few pages, including the profile page, picture and sound input, and search pages. For example, we intend to add a general search that allows the user to find specific stories or pieces of information, as well as a search in the moderate task that allows the user to find contacts for specific topics.
