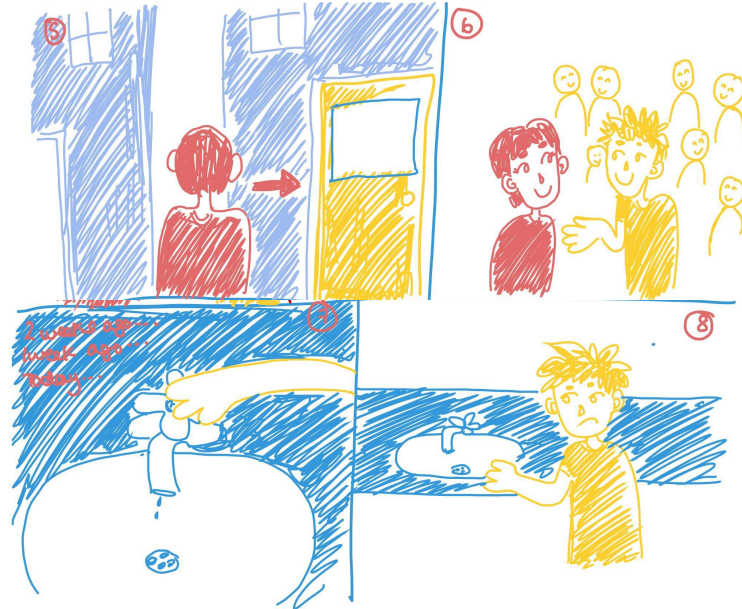
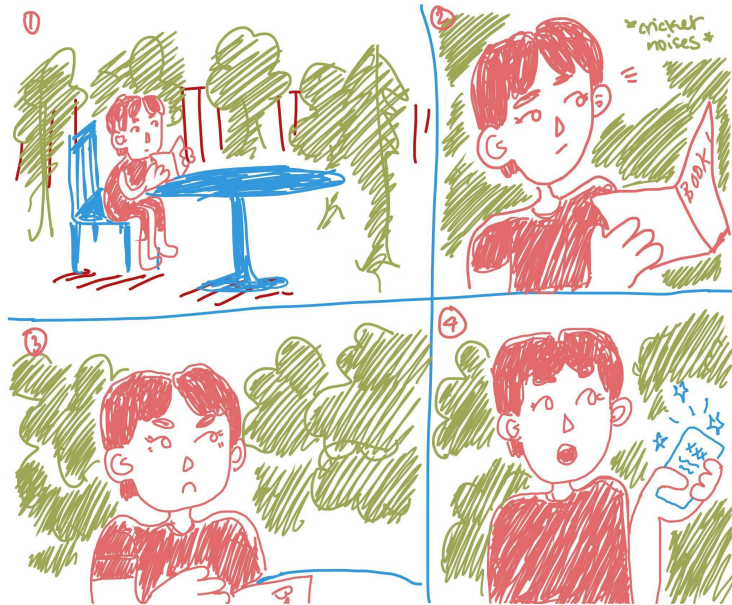
## **Three Tasks:**

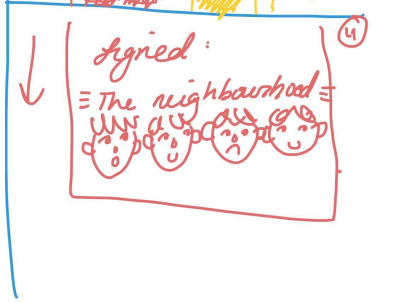
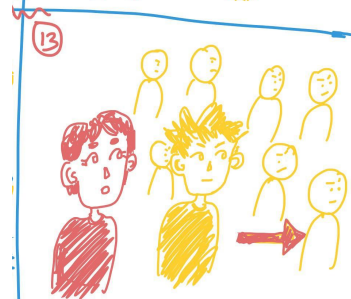
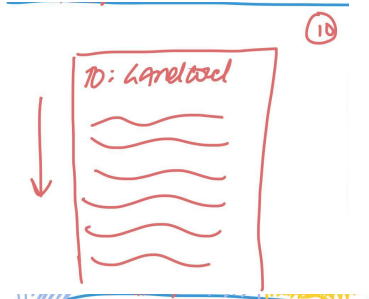
## **Three Tasks:**

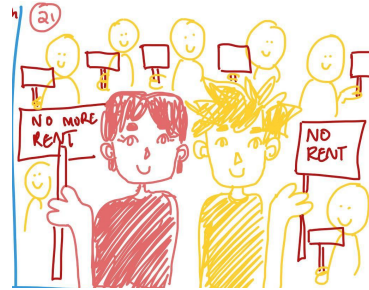
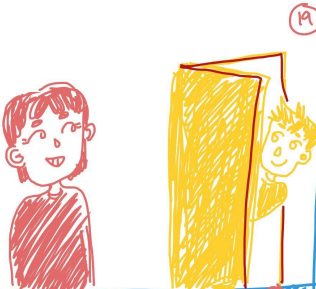
