

Inspo ReadMe

We developed and exported our application through Expo. We submitted our Expo credentials through the React Native Registration form, so you should be able to access our prototype there. Sign in to Expo using those credentials on the [Expo Go app](#) and run the latest iOS Inspo build (under the Profile tab).

Entering the app is easy. If you'd like to skip the sign-in process, simply press "Sign in with google." Otherwise, you can enter a username and password and you'll be allowed into the app.

The first page you will see is the inspo page. The inspo page

has prompts on the top. Press the quill button to start writing a story with the given prompt. Next up is the graveyard section. Here you'll find older stories you were never in love with. You can jump right back into them by pressing the edit button to the right. Lastly, you'll see the stories others' have shared with you. Simply tap on the read button and you'll be able to examine them in their entirety. Press the check to return to the inspo page.

Next is the write page. This is the page where you can write new stories or edit old ones. To type, simply press in the text box on the lower half of the screen and start typing. To change the title, simply press on the title section and start typing. You can get new prompts at any time by tapping the quill in the bottom right. This will display a window with prompts you can cycle through by swiping or tapping. Lastly, press the check mark when you're done with your story.

The pop-up window will give you the options to continue editing, save to drafts, send to graveyard, or share with friends. While the first three behave like expected, sharing will bring you to a page that displays your friends and lets you select who to share with. You can then send, and you'll be returned to inspo.

Lastly, the drafts page is where you'll see all your saved drafts. You can choose to edit them, which sends you to the writing page, or share them, which sends you directly to the share page.
