The college application process is convoluted and stress-inducing. The application is unintuitive and information about how to apply is not consolidated in one place.


Solution




Design Change #1: Severity 3-4

H1: Visibility of Status


"Going back to home after selecting universities does not preserve those selections. Only the username is preserved" (Severity 3)

"No confirmation that the school has been added to the cart" (Severity 2)



Fix #1

- Use AsyncStorage in ReactNative to save user's cart selections and application information



Design Change #2: Severity 3-4


H2: Match Between System and World

"List of universities recommended are confusing, why have they been recommended to me?" (Severity 3)



Fix #2

- Focus on recommendations
 based on location
- Particularly relevant to our audience of community college applicants





Design Change #3: Severity 3-4

"No option to exit out after searching for a college" (Severity 4)






Design Change #4: Severity 3-4


H4: Consistency and Standards


"College Cart scrolling is incomplete can't see the "View Application" button of the last college" (Severity 4)

Scrolls down to the bottom of the CollegeCart list










