Virtual concerts do not allow for meaningful interactions between audience members, and with the performer. They also omit key parts of the pre-concert experience.


Solution


Our solution allows you to enjoy performances with your friends, and interact with the performer. We create a cohesive collective experience for before, during, and after the performance.

Task 1: Invite your squad to a pre - concert room

Heuristic Violations

H4: Consistency & Standards

Users were confused about how rooms are related to one another within a concert

H1: Visibility of System Status


Lacked confirmation screen for creation of pre-concert room

H3: User Control & Freedom

Users were unable to invite additional friends after sending the initial batch of invitations


Resolution


- Created a "My Rooms" screen
- This shows all the rooms a user has created & been invited to, and which concerts they are associated with.
- Users can invite friends from this screen



Task 2:

Customize your room's to your squad's likings (Original)





Heuristic Violations

H3: User Control & Freedom

Users weren't able to see other people's votes on the customization screen

H3: User Control & Freedom

Users weren't able to view or change their customization settings freely after creating the room

Resolution

- Removed voting feature encouraging users to customize room in "My Rooms" or together in the Pre-Concert Room
- Added a settings tab allowing users to see the games they have queued for the room
- Included room information in the "My Rooms" tab
