How to Use

We made our prototype on Figma, so it can be used through their prototype tool at the link above. It emulates using an iPhone 11 Pro.

Additional usage notes:

- **When on the “you are flowing” screen, wait 10 seconds before it will automatically advance to the next screen.** This emulates when the allotted flow time is finished.
- To find out which buttons are clickable on a screen, tap any open area.
- Press Restart at the bottom right at any point to go back to the beginning.

After going through onboarding, you will be presented with the three tasks in the app:

- *Home*, where you can start a flow session,
 - *Journal*, where you can see useful statistics and a list of your past flows, and
 - *Goals*, where you can see your flow goals and create new ones.

Limitations

The medium-fi prototype has these limitations on Figma that we will fix in the hi-fi prototype:

Home

- When starting a flow session, only one goal can be selected to continue to the next step
 - In the hi-fi prototype, the user will be able to input a custom task for the flow session, or choose any one of their existing goals
- Once a goal is selected, the user is presented multiple options, including flow time, distraction blocking, and distraction setting, which are not editable
- Once a flow session is started, a timer isn't started, but instead users are directed to the next screen after 10 seconds
- The screen allowing a user to reflect has isn't editable

Journal

- The journal doesn't calculate real metrics about usage
- Only one flow section is clickable in the timeline tab

Goals

- Only one goal is clickable
- New goal screen is viewable but can't create a new goal

Wizard of Oz Techniques

The prototype advances automatically during a flow session to the next screen after 10 seconds.

Hard-coded Data

The prototype emulates a user who has been using the app for at least a week, with 7+ previous flow sessions, and 4 flow goals. This allows the prototype to display the full interface with useful data. We also hard-coded user input in several places.
