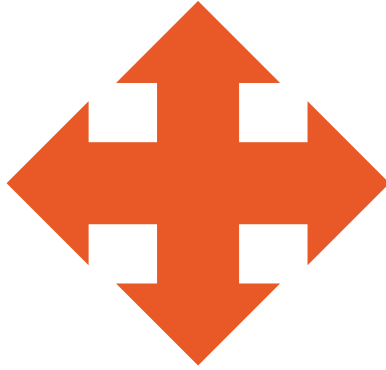

Problem

People who cook can have difficulty finding recipes that align with their **dietary restrictions** and **preferences**.

Making modifications to recipes to fit their needs complicates the process of figuring out what **nutrients** are in the food they make and eat.

Recipal aims to help users **overcome uncertainty** about the recipes they are making by helping them **understand nutritional value, make modifications,** and **learn cooking techniques.**

Heuristic Evaluation Results





64 total violations

1 severity 0

19 severity 1

24 severity 2

14 severity 3

1 severity 4



Most violated heuristics

Type of Heuristic

Description

Action

H1 Visibility of System Status

Unclear if recipe search is based on dietary restriction/nutritional preference filters

Fix: If the recipe violates one of the user's diet, it will appear with an exclamation point

H2 Match between System and World

Cannot change the units into what I am familiar with.

Fix: Add a customary/metric toggle on the Me page

H3 User Control and freedom

Cannot navigate freely through recipe, skipping steps by tapping on progress dots

Will not fix: We are following convention about dots not being functional

H3 User Control & Freedom

User may want to quit out of the recipe and save progress but can not.

Fix: Add "save progress" button when prompting for exit

H3 User Control and Freedom

User not given visual prompt of how to change increments, can't decrease quantity

Fix: the inclusion of either a scroll menu or increment/decrement arrows to modify quantity

H4 Consistency and Standards

Back button in "Recipe Steps" cancels whole recipe instead of going back to ingredients page

Fix: Change the back button to an exit button

H7 Flexibility & Efficiency of Use	Home page has no purpose other than fun fact	Fix: Combine home page and recipe category select into one page
H7 Flexibility & Efficiency of Use	Users have to click on each recipe or each ingredient to learn more	Fix: Include high-level nutritional facts and information about recipe on label
H7 Flexibility and efficiency of use	Cannot save the modified recipe.	Will not fix: Cannot implement in timeframe, requires accounts/cloud database
H8 Aesthetic and Minimalist Design	“Add” and other directives are in different font than other text	Fix: Rely on one or two default fonts
H9 Help users recognize, diagnose, and recover from errors	No error message alerting that ingredient is essential, user should add ingredient back.	Fix: Add an error message that alerts the user to add the essential ingredient back
H9 Help Users Recognize, Diagnose, and Recover From Errors	Modification warning message doesn't state the exact nature of the violation	Fix: Specify that limits will be per meal. Error message will include what the exceeded limit was/how this modification exceeds it
H11 Accessible	All pages purely visual and don't offer text-based alternatives for users with low vision.	Will not fix: Text has screen readers. For the icons, we plan to provide alt-text.

Violation: Home page has no purpose other than fun fact

Fix: Combine home page and recipe category select into one page

Med-Fi Prototype

Learnability: Improved **Flexibility: Same**

Learnability: Less navigation makes the app easier to learn to use

2. Clearly informing how recipe search uses user restrictions

H7 Flexibility & Efficiency of Use



Violation: Unclear if recipe search is based on dietary restriction/nutritional preference filters



Fix: If the recipe violates one of the user's diet, it will appear with an exclamation point

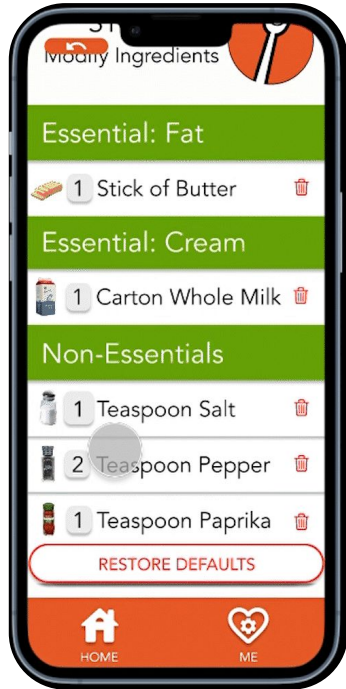


Learnability: Improved ***Flexibility: Improved***

Learnability: Better warning icons lets users learn what they can and cannot do and why

Flexibility: New warning icon makes choosing recipes more safe for all users

3. Clearly indicating how modifications violate user preferences



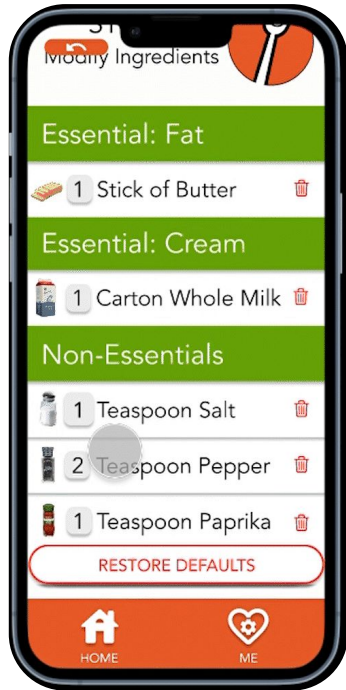

H9 Help Users Recognize, Diagnose, and Recover From Errors

Violation: Modification warning message doesn't state the exact nature of the violation

Fix: Specify that limits will be per meal. Error message will include what the exceeded limit was/how this modification exceeds it

Flexibility: Better explanation makes making modifications more safe for all users



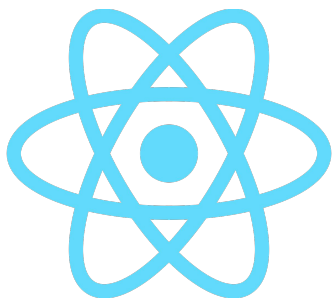

Wizard of Oz Techniques

Nutrition limits are not calculated faithfully and use crude estimates

- Each ingredient is pre-labeled with a nutrient per unit ratio
- e.g. fettuccine pasta: 7g carbohydrates / oz

Issues/Questions

Switching between customary and metric

- Varies by ingredient (weight vs. volume)
- e.g. a cup of feathers is heavier than a cup of marbles

- 15 total severity 3-4 issues found (one 4 and fourteen 3's)
- Will address most of the issues

Prototype Implementation Status

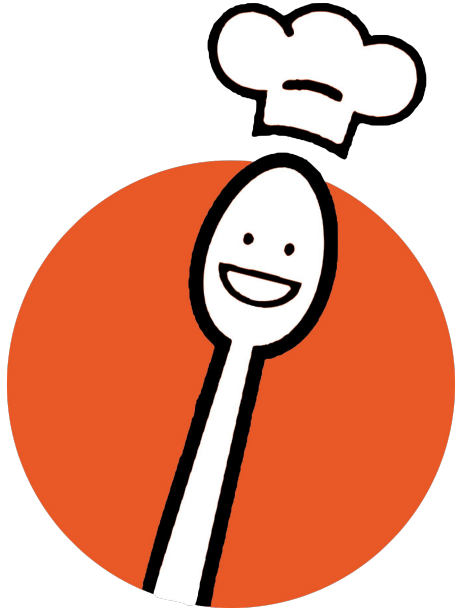
- Completed layout, modifications, and nutrition warnings
