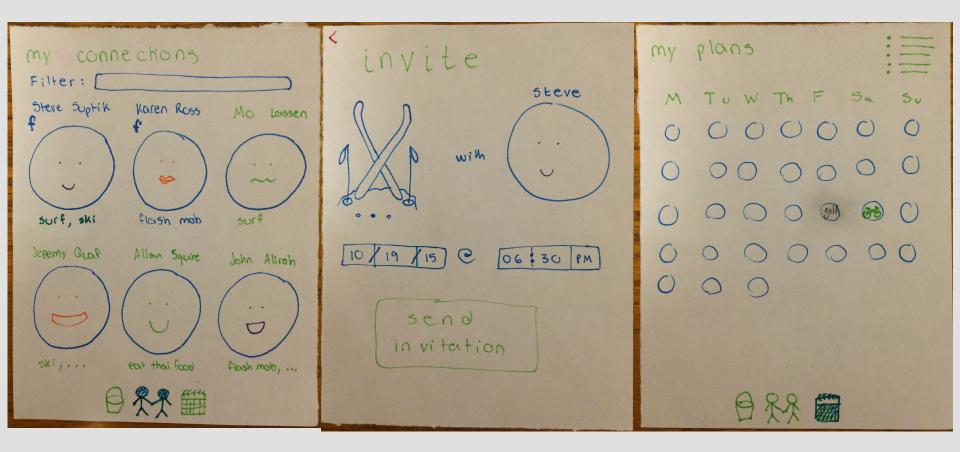

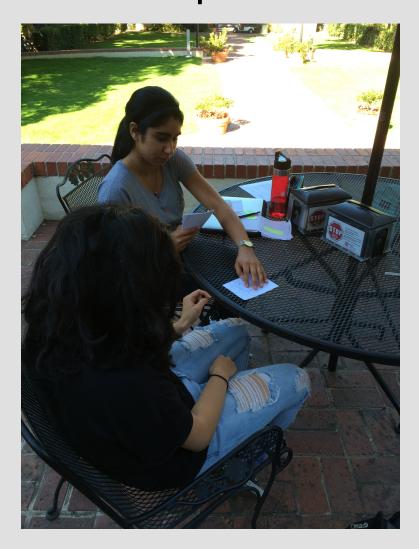

TESTING & RESULTS

Experimental Methods



- One of us is "computer"
 - No talking
 - Displays screens
 - Adds keyboard (as needed)
- Other person is narrator
 - Introduces product
 - Asks user to complete tasks
- User asked to vocalize rationale for choices

User #1 Feedback

"My personal inclination would be to not link with Facebook"

"It's pretty easy to see my bucket list"



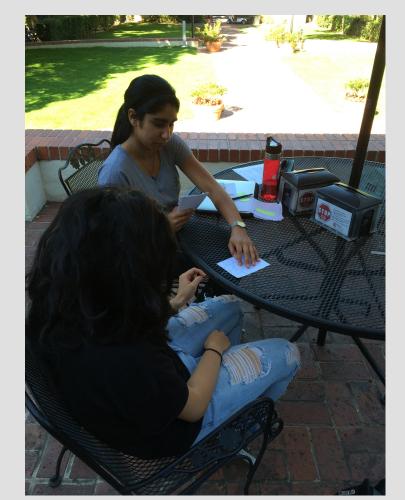
"Oh! I get it now!" – after initial confusion with scheduling a task

> "I wouldn't know that clicking on a bucket list item would send an invite"

User # 2 Feedback

"Uh...." – when prompted to add things to bucket list

"It's hard for me to nail down a specific time in advance. Maybe just 'this weekend'?"



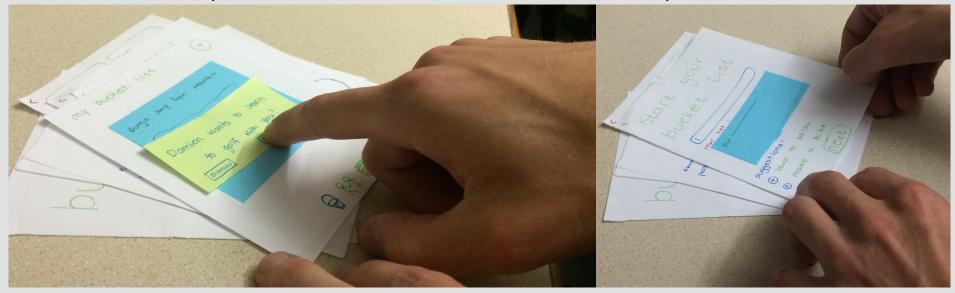
[dismisses message] "Notifications inside app are weird"

Clicked through tasks easily

Immediately chose to connect to Facebook

User #3 Feedback

Easily invited someone based on the activity, not person Clicked through scheduling tasks pretty smoothly



Thought the bucket icon was a trash can Confused by profile creation

Overall Impressions

Positive

- Suggested communities
- Suggested list items
- Inspired by others lists
- Task flow is relatively straightforward

Needs work

- What to put on list
- Hesitation to accept invites
- Scheduling and chat
- Notifications

UI CHANGES

Adding to Bucket List

- More suggestions
- Maybe don't display the screen right away
- Change bucket logo make it explicit



Accepting an Invite

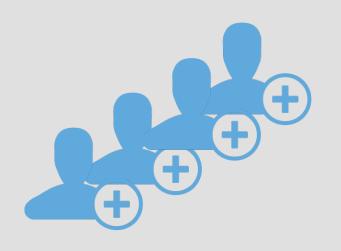
- Inbox vs. notifications
- Make proposing a new time easier
- More intuitive chat





Sending an Invite

- Make it clearer where this process starts
- Make it more obvious who shares interests
- More ambiguous times
- Ability to invite multiple people





Conclusion
