additional gathered information

- “strange to use phone app on a computer”
- “saving was tiny bit confusing”
- “after some trouble shooting though, the user will figure it out”
- “an onboarding tutorial would be really nice”
- “I like the messaging even though we didn’t do any. I like the idea of networking on here”
- “this would be really useful”

T2

additional gathered information

- “How is archived different from saved?”
- **Need to consider rewording saved, archived, bookmark**
- ‘Archive’ label should be further evaluated. Archive in Instagram has different meaning
- **Swapping between answered and unanswered was easy**
- Upvoting was not familiar to tester

additional gathered information

- “I get how the app works because it similar to Instagram which I am familiar with”
- “It would be nice to have a tutorial on what buttons do and how to post a quest...etc”
- **“Overall, I think it’s pretty cool and this app would definitely help people especially high school students who know what they want to get to know more of”**
- Would be comfortable posting (likes the anonymity)





additional gathered information

- “I like the layouts of the topics in the forum list were clear”
- **“Like the active now so you know if there are people there to respond to you”**
- “Bookmark is clear but not clear where to find them after”
- “Is the author the only person answering?”
- **“It’s nice that you don’t have to ask but still get information”**
- Like the option of remaining anonymous
- Would like a “while you were away” feature

Things we might change

- bookmark vs saved
 - be more consistent with icons and labels
- archived forums vs past forums
 - what's more intuitive?
- further evaluate the add question button
 - make it a floating footer cell that is always on screen
- continue to implement more features
 - unique profiles
 - creating forum
 - messaging


